RE	Internet – You Tube	<p><u>Learning Question: Can I learn about the significance of the golden temple?</u></p> <p>Children to watch this: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Qiz2TVPN9TU</p> <p>Children should then create a poster advertising the temple highlighting its main features and why it is important for Sikhs to worship there.</p>
