

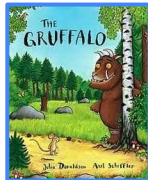
This is an overview of the learning that will be taking place in Year 1 this half term. Knowledge organisers can also be found on the Year 1 page on the website with additional information about the curriculum topics.

English

We will be reading 'The Gruffalo' and 'The Three Little Pigs'

We will be learning about:

- The alphabet.
- Holding a pencil comfortably and correctly.
- Applying phonic knowledge.
- Composing a sentence orally.
- Using finger spaces.



Maths

We will be learning about place value within 10. We will:

- Count objects.
- Count forwards and backwards.
- Find 1 more and 1 less.
- Compare numbers.
- Learn about the number line.



Science

Our topic is 'Animals, including humans'

We will be learning to

- Name body parts and identify their functions.
- Link senses to different body parts.
- Create simple graphs.
- Make predictions and record results.

History

Our topic is 'Am I making history?'

We will be learning to:

- Explain what makes an event important.
- Identify key events in my life so far.
- Explain what a family tree is.
- Describe the history of my family.
- Show how I am part of history.

Art

Our topic is 'Drawing.'

We will be:

- Exploring different lines.
- Drawing 2D and irregular shapes.
- Exploring the medium of pencils and felt tips.

RE

We are focussing on Christianity. We will be learning about:

- Creation and what it means.
- The Christian creation story.



PSHE

Our topic is 'Being me in my world'

We will be learning about:

- Feeling special and safe.
- Being part of a class.
- Rights and responsibilities.
- Rewards and feeling proud.
- Consequences.

Music

We will be learning how to keep a steady beat. We will march, clap or sway in time.



PE

In PE we will learning to develop our Fundamental Movements Skills.

- Footwork - moving from side to side in different directions / galloping / skipping.
- Static balance on one leg.
