Curriculum Newsletter

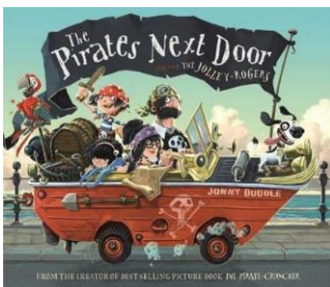
Dear Parent and Carers,

English

This term we are looking at different pirate stories. We will be looking at using exciting vocabulary in our work and securing our knowledge of conjunctions and suffix endings. We will be learning to edit our work. We will also be practicing our handwriting, ensuring it is always neat and joined.



Maths

We will continue to look at the four main operations - addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will then be focusing on SATs style questions and looking specifically at the vocabulary. *You can support your child* by encouraging them to complete Pixl times tables.

Connected Curriculum

Our topic this term is called 'Land Ahoy!' and is all about pirates. We will be learning about the history of pirates and facts about famous pirates throughout time. We will be making treasure maps, writing directions, learning about the life of pirates and even trying to talk like a pirate!
